Fri, 10/11 Best of Machine Technique Sampler (pictured left)

Techniques taught in this all-day workshop include: Award-winning machine reverse applique, Prairie Points and their application in 21st Century artwork, Afghani Piecework, Dimensional flowers and knots, Piping and Corded Piping, Rickrack flowers, and the use of rickrack and how to applied rickrack on quilts.

Sat, 10/12 Intersecting Rings (pictured right)

Learn an unusual technique for stitching complex pieced blocks accurately. Draw your own 14" - 17" design on freezer paper using a yardstick compass, or create a 42" x 46" wall quilt, which you can start in class using the provided pattern. This is not paper-piecing! And, although this workshop features curved designs, the same technique is equally suitable for a linear design. Students will quickly see the design possibilities that can result when using this technique

Fri, 1/10 Thread Sketching - Snowflakes

Let it snow, let it snow, let it snow! Whip up your very own flurry in this class, using thread, fabric and a tiny bit of paint. You'll learn the basics of how to thread sketch, using my patterns for gorgeous, realistic looking snowflakes.



Sat, 1/11 Wholecloth Painting - Botanicals

Students will learn the basics of creating wholecloth painted quilts based on photos. Students can choose from the four projects shown, and will work from line drawings and my photos to recreate the image using acrylic textile paints. Afraid to try this technique? Don't be! My students get great results.

Fri, 3/13 Semaphore Stripes (pictured left)

The Semaphore Stripes quilt is the perfect way to use striped fabric to make a secondary design without all the complicated piecing that stripes typically require, and it's jelly-roll friendly! This quilt combines strip piecing with a few well-placed Y seams to get the most dramatic effect.

Sat, 3/14 Double Struck Stars (pictured right)

This cheerful modern quilt is a great stash buster. The colors shade from light to dark so it looks like it is exploding.

You'll be "making" fabric using bricks, strips, and scraps. Some great swapping will expand your fabric selections for even more fun.

Sat, 5/16 Solar Flare (pictured right)
