Display Category

We know we have some members of our guild who would like to exhibit their quilts at our show, but are not interested in having their quilts judged. Accordingly, we have created a “Display” category.

DISPLAY - Quilts in this category will be used within the exhibition hall to add ambience to our show. These quilts will not be judged and are not eligible for awards. No Skill Levels. No size restrictions (except less than 110" x 110"). Only one entry per individual. Limited to the first 15 entries. Entry fee required. Complete the 2018 Quilt Show Special Exhibit Entry Form.

Special Exhibit Spotlight

We have several special exhibits that will be created by our guild members. All members are encouraged to participate in our “3-D” and “InJEANious” exhibits.

3-D – Items in this category must be three dimensional. Size is limited to no more than 18" on any one measurement. Items must be “textile” in nature and contain cloth, fiber, or yarns. Open Skill Levels. Your 3-D items will be judged and are eligible to win awards and be considered for “Viewer’s Choice.”

“InJEANious” GUILD CHALLENGE - If your quilt is part of the Guild Challenge, it will not be judged or available for any quilt show awards or “Viewer’s Choice.” It will be voted on by quilt show attendees. Monetary awards will be presented by the Challenge Coordinators. Complete the 2018 Quilt Show Special Exhibit Entry Form. Because this is guild sponsored, no entry fee is required.

ThreadTales will display quilts that reflect a year in literature.

The **Vagabonds** special exhibit features 12 quilts made from couture wedding gowns. Be prepared to be dazzled with their wedding theme.

This year's Quilt Show program will be 8 ½" high x 7" wide.

Jelly Roll Race

We will accept a limited number of team registrations for this event. Follow the YouTube from Missouri Star Quilt Company to see a demonstration on how to make a jelly roll quilt. With your team of two, one will be your seamstress on the sewing machine; the other, the helper extraordinaire who can trim seams allowances, find the buried ends of the strips, and help feed the fabrics to the seamstress. Each team will need to provide their sewing machine and threads. (Irons not required!)

Each team will pay a registration fee of \$10 which will be donated to Comfort Quilts. The jelly rolls will be provided by Comfort Quilts. The finished quilt tops that are created will be returned to Comfort Quilts to finish and distribute in our community.

The winning team of two will each receive one free edge-to-edge quilting by the Comfort Quilts team. Second and Third place winners will also receive a prize. It's a win-win-win-win. (Win for the Comfort Quilts team, win for the 2-member team, win for our community, and entertainment for the quilt show spectators.)
