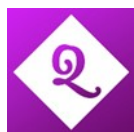

How do you find QuiltSpace to use on your portable electronic device? Search for "QuiltSpace" in Apple's App Store or on Android's Google Play. After the app is downloaded to your phone or tablet, use your email to sign up and click on our show.

During the show, you will be able to use the app for a:

- Gallery of quilt photos
- Live feed – add in your own photos
- Schedule of events
- List of vendors
- Create your own schedule
- Find out who else is using the app

We don't have all the details yet, but you can expect some contests using this app. After the show, you can continue to share photos and chats.
