## Our 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual Clark County Quilters Quilt Show is now in the history books.

Our quilt show is a way for us to share our craft, passion and talent. Those traits were shared not only in the quilts you shared, but in your volunteer efforts. Without you, this event would not have been the show it was. Many elements made this show what it was: the quilts, the volunteers, the publicity, the venue, the guests, the activities, the vendors, the sponsors, and the income for our guild's charitable works.

We had **quilts**. Over 525 quilts were on display. Almost 300 ribbons were awarded to our guild members.

Our Volunteer Co-chairs, Rosemary Griggs and Lyn Nelson, filled over 152 volunteer slots. We know there were more than that too. Many of you came every day with a smile and a “How can I help?” salutation.

We had **attendees**. Every day we had about 500 paid visitors, 60 CCQ volunteers, 50 vendors, 4-5 Event Center staff, and 5-10 complimentary ticket holders in our Hall. We had a former CCQ member from the Olympia area who hadn't been back in 30 years. We had another guest who remembered the people who worked on the Fort Vancouver Tapestry.

We had **activities**.

- Hands-on quilting demonstration
- Portland Bead Society “Look Over My Shoulder” demonstrations
- Lectures and demonstrations from vendors and members

We had **sponsors**. We are grateful to Boersma's, Quilting Delights, Fabric Depot, Craft Warehouse, and Quiltspace for supporting our guild's show. We had many guild sponsors as well. Thank you for your generosity.

We had **vendors**. 33 to be exact. Some were new; some have been with us many years. They always appreciate the kindness and efficient assistance they receive from our volunteers. They provided donations for our gift baskets. Judy Johnson, our Threadmongers vendor, wrote: “This was the best guild quilt show I have ever seen. Just blown away.”

We had **income**. Our show isn't just about the money we raise, but we know those statistics are important. We don't have a final net income figure because we're still waiting for some final invoices and deposits. And, these numbers do not reflect Event Center deposits we've made for 2019 and 2020.

- Total income was about \$33,000
- Total expenses are about \$18,000
- Net income should be between \$14,000 to \$16,000

We'll have a final accounting within the next 30 days.
