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Supply Lists (choose either option A or B below)

6-hour workshop

OPTION A:

Supplies To Make Large Quilt In Your Own Color Palette

1. Sewing machine and everything you need to sew with it. (Featherweight Singer is the perfect machine for this technique. Bring yours if you own one and bring the original zipper foot, too.)
 2. Open-toe appliqué foot (Bernina #20) and ¼" foot (Bernina #37 or #57)
 3. Olfa matt, rotary cutter, 6" x 12" ruler and 6" x 24" ruler
 4. Traveling steam iron and ironing surface (No hand size or tiny irons)
 5. Several #2 pencils, pencil sharpener, and pencil eraser
 6. Glue stick – water soluble or permanent
 7. Marking pencils for transferring registration marks to fabric. Bring 1 for dark fabrics and 1 for light fabrics.
 8. New Schmetz sewing machine needle, #80 Sharp
 9. Fine pins for piecing (not long quilting pins, please)
 10. Paper scissors and Fabric scissors
 11. Spray Starch – buy a bottle of liquid starch and pour into trigger-handled, spray bottle; dilute 50% with H2O and shake to mix OR buy (1) expensive spray can from grocery store! Mary Ellen's "Best Press™" is okay.
- 12.7 – 14 Fat Quarters** of fabric for backgrounds. (My backgrounds are yellow and orange, or a combo of both hues. Background fabrics can all be different color, value, or all the same print).



13. **Fabric for your 7 rings – at least a half-yard of each.** They should contrast with your background fabrics. One of my rings is purple, one is red, one is pink, and another is a floral with a green background.
14. **Inner border** – a long $\frac{1}{4}$ yard (9" x WOF) to contrast with both background and rings.
15. **Outer border** – $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ of a yard (I do not choose borders before I piece the rings; in other words, you do not need border fabrics for the workshop!)
16. **"Machine wash and dry all fabrics before the workshop!"**
17. Thread for piecing that blends with Rings and Background fabrics.
18. One spool thread that contrasts with Ring fabrics. Should be a medium-dark to dark value.
19. 7 linear feet of Reynold's Freezer Paper (buy the widest you can find)
20. **Optional** (*bring if you already own*): 20" x 20" square ruler

OPTION B

Supplies To Make An Original 14"X 14" Rings Block:

Bring all the supplies in #1 – #11 above, plus the items in 20 and 21 below. Bring fabric requirements as specified in #22 below.

21. Small compass (like you used in school to draw circles) I will bring large compasses that attach to wooden or plastic dowels, and metal rods.
22. Freezer paper – 14" x 14"
23. 5 fat quarters in varied colors and values
