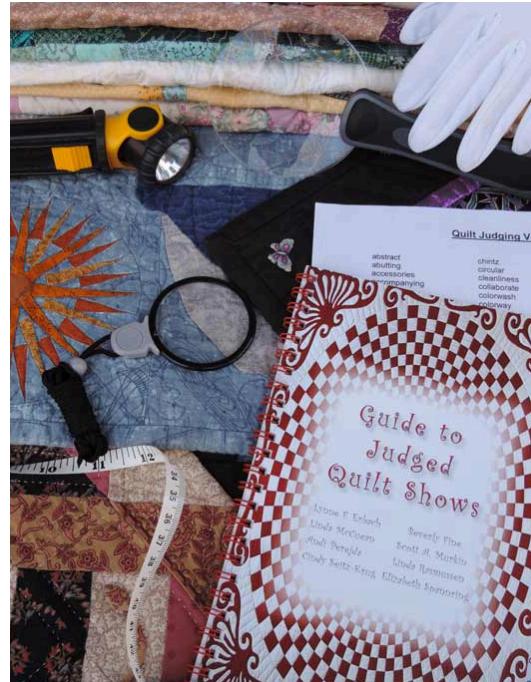


## **Introduction to Judging: Two-Day Seminar**

- Are you interested in learning to judge quilts and wearables?
- Are you coordinating the judging for your guild show?
- Do you enter quilt shows and want to understand what it takes to make a winning quilt?
- Or maybe you have attended a quilt show and asked yourself, as many quilters do, "What were the judges thinking?" And you just want to learn more.



This workshop will answer all of your questions no matter your reason for attending.

Learn through discussions, power point presentations, interactive exercises, and hands-on mock judging. The workshop covers all aspects of quilt judging, including the job of judging, evaluating design and workmanship, categories and awards, judging systems, setting up the judging floor, and judging versus jurying. Discussion includes certification requirements for the NACQJ, the only national certifying organization for judges.
