

Couched Pouch Supply list

If you are not using a classroom machine you will need to bring:

Sewing Machine in good working order. Your machine must have the ability to do a zig-zag. Decorative stitches are great too! Please familiarize yourself with your machine before you come to class. Learn how to set your machine to make a zig-zag and decorative stitches, and how to adjust the width and length.

Instruction book for your machine

Embroidery foot for your machine. If you're not sure which one this is, bring what you have.

Zipper Foot

Regular sewing Foot or ¼" foot

A bobbin filled with black thread

All students need to bring:

Black Thread

Size 75/11 Embroidery or 80/12 Metallic Needle. I will have these on hand if you are unsure.

Vertical spool holder (One that holds the thread up and down, with the thread pulling sideways off the spool, not from the top.)

Thread Snips

Rotary Cutter and 12" or 24" Ruler

Chalk Pencil or pen that will write on dark fabric

If you have these, bring them:

Machine Embroidery thread. Rayon, Cotton, Metallic, any size up to 10 wt. 60 wt. doesn't really show up, but bring it if you want to try it out. Variegated, shiny, or glitzy works best.

Scraps of Yarn, Embroidery floss, ribbon, silk ribbon, trims, mini rick-rack, up to ¼" wide. The funkier the better.

I will have a stash of all kinds of fun stuff for you to try out, so no worries if you don't have any of these fun threads.

I will be providing the rest of the materials. If there is a particular fabric you'd like to use as your lining, bring it. You'll need a fat quarter.
