

3-D WHIMSICAL COTTAGES

Learn how to make your own quilted, hand dyed and embellished 3 dimensional "Tiny House".

Kit fee of \$7 includes:

Instructions

Felt ball for the roof top

Cottage foundation fabric

Fabric paint for surface decoration

Brush

Supply List

ALL your fabric needs to be 100% cotton

Please PRECUT the following before class:

Approximately 225 linear inches of an assortment of light colored fabrics and selvages (I like the selvages the best!) for the house body. Cut these strips at different widths (1/4" -1/2"), then subcut them into 6"-8" lengths. Put them in a ziplock baggie.

Approximately 220 linear inches of COLORED strips (1/4"-1/2" wide), subcut into 6"-8" strips. It is probably in your best interest to stay in one color range for these strips. Put them in a separate baggie.

Quilt basting spray

Sewing machine in good working order: including power cord, extension cord, foot or knee control, extra needles, extra bobbins and instruction manual. The machine you bring needs to have the capability to stitch an applique zig zag stitch (decorative stitches are always fun, too!). Different feet are a plus...if you have them (i.e. a walking foot or an open toe foot).

A school type water color set with pans or cakes of watercolors. Prang is a good brand. they cost approximately \$4 at Office Depot or Walmart. Tube watercolors (if you have them) also work beautifully.

Foam stamps if desired (I will bring some, too)

Sewing scissors

Paper scissors

Freezer paper

Pencil

Hand sewing needles

Straight pins if you think you will want them to hold things in place

A long dollmaker's needle IF you have one (I will bring some)

Small cutting mat 9" x 12" is okay

Rotary cutter

Cutting ruler of choice

Polyster stuffing

Teflon pressing cloth OR parchment paper to protect iron surfaces

About a 1" stack of newspaper

Your choice of embellishments: buttons, large and small beads, ephemera, additional fabric scraps (for doors and windows), ribbon, lace, ephemera, ric rac, embroidery floss, flat metal beads or discs, and anything else you want to add!

COTTON quilting thread in a variety of colors : including one light colored, one to match or contrast the roof color you have chosen, one to sew the house together (matching or contrasting...your choice) and some for embellishment attachment

A small piece of beeswax

A plastic kitchen garbage bag to protect the table from paint

I will bring paint pallettes and water containers as well as irons, ironing boards and hair dryers, but if a few of you could bring extra irons, ironing boards and hair dryers that would be great.
